



Admission Policies

*Because Greater Alachua County Fair is a family fair,
we expect guests to behave appropriately.*

Unruly, disruptive or offensive behavior, including line-jumping and profanity, is strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated.

Violating our Fair policies may be cause for ejection from the Fair without refund. For more information, please review the fair policies below:

GUEST SAFETY: Guests are subject to inspection and or electronic screenings at the Front Gate. Greater Alachua County Fair and Belle City Amusements reserve the right to inspect all packages, purses, backpacks and fanny packs prior to entering the Fair. Sharp objects, weapons and illegal contraband are not permitted into the fair. Please leave any unnecessary articles in your vehicle to expedite your entry. We recommend that you secure such items in the trunk of your vehicle.

BEHAVIOR: We expect all guests to behave in a family-friendly manner. Please walk at all times inside the fair. Do not sit or stand, on fences or railings. Line-jumping, profanity and unruly behavior are offensive to fair guests and may be cause for ejection without refund. Guests are not permitted to save places in line, bypass others in line, or exit the line and return to the same place for any reason. Guests exiting a line must go to the back of the line if they decide to return.

DRESS CODE: In keeping with our family-friendly atmosphere, and for health and safety reasons, Greater Alachua County Fair strictly enforces a dress code. Proper attire must be worn at all times, including shirts and appropriate footwear. Clothing with rude, vulgar or offensive language or graphics is not permitted, and shirts cannot be turned inside-out as a solution. Fair admission may be denied if clothing is deemed by management to be inappropriate. Shirt, shoes, and a bottom (shorts, pants, skirt, etc) must be worn at all times in the fair.

LANGUAGE: Guests using profanity or abusive language, symbols or gestures may be ejected from the fair without refund.

FAIR POLICY COMPLIANCE: In addition to the Greater Alachua County Fair and Belle City Amusements Guest Code of Conduct, guests are required to comply with all local, state and federal laws, as well as individual fair policies, rules and instructions posted or otherwise listed.

PETS: Animals are not allowed in the fair, with the exception of service animals used by the hearing and visually impaired. For the health and safety of your pet, do not leave it in your car for any length of time while visiting the fair. Greater Alachua County Fair will call Animal Services to rescue your pet at your expense, which may also result in prosecution.

FOOD, DRINKS AND COOLERS: Food, beverages or coolers may not be brought into the fair. The only exceptions are for allergy restrictions and infant food.

PROHIBITED ITEMS: In addition to all items previously mentioned, the following items are not permitted at the Greater Alachua County Fair, at any time:

- Lawn chairs and folding chairs
- Magic markers, spray paint and aerosol cans
- Glass bottles
- Knives
- Spiked clothing or jewelry
- Fireworks and explosives
- Firearms and ammunition
- Chemical weapons, including mace and pepper spray

BEVERAGES: No beverages of any kind can be brought into Greater Alachua County Fair.

RE-ENTRY: No re-entry or pass outs of any kind. You leave the fair you will need to purchase another entrance ticket. It is essential to carry your entrance ticket at all times while in the Fair.

COMMERCIAL PHOTOGRAPHY: By entering the fair, each guest grants Greater Alachua County Fair the right to film, videotape, or photograph him/her on fair property for any reason without payment or consideration. Guests must have written permission to use photographs and/or videotape of Greater Alachua County Fair images for commercial broadcasting, advertising, marketing or publishing in any medium.

RIDER RESPONSIBILITY: There is an inherent risk in participating in any amusement ride. We expect riders to exercise good judgment and act in a responsible manner. Guests must

also obey all oral and written warnings and properly use all ride safety equipment provided. Guests who do not comply with ride rules may be ejected from the fair without refund. Please refer to specific guidelines posted at the entrance of every ride.

RIDE RESTRICTIONS: Safety is our number-one priority. Guests with certain body proportions, or of certain heights and/or weights, may not be able to enjoy certain rides if the safety restraints will not operate as designed. There are manufacturer recommended height and/or weight restrictions to all rides.

LINE-JUMPING: Line-jumping is strictly prohibited. Guests are not permitted to save places in line or exit the line and return for any reason. Violators will be ejected without a refund.

LOOSE ARTICLES: Loose articles are not permitted on most rides and should be left with non-riders. Greater Alachua County Fair and its employees, contractors, vendors and volunteers are not responsible for lost or stolen items. Loose articles of any kind (including but not limited to purses, backpacks, and beverage containers) may not be taken past the queue entrance and cannot be left on the load/unload platform of any ride; Cell phones, glasses and/or other small items must be secured in cargo pockets, zippered jacket pockets, or waist packs. All loose articles which cannot be secured must be left in your car or with a non-rider prior to entering the queue line.

PHOTOGRAPHY: Cameras are not permitted on thrill rides. Greater Alachua County Fair requests that all photographs or videos taken by guests be used for their personal use and enjoyment only. Any use, reuse or reproduction for commercial purposes without the express written consent of Greater Alachua County Fair and Belle City Amusements is prohibited.
